Welcome back to year 6

Welcome back to a new school year and to year 6! I am very excited to be able to work with the children again this year and I am looking forward to sharing with them what I hope will be a fun, enjoyable and engaging last year at primary school. As well as being the last year of primary school year 6 also comes with a number of distinct responsibilities. We will be looking to appoint house captains, as well as head boy and head girl and throughout the year the children will be expected to model their outstanding behaviour and work ethic and set the example to the rest of the children in the school.



In order to begin preparing the children for secondary school we will also be placing a lot more emphasis on things such as homework and developing a sense of independence when learning.

Our Curriculum

Our connections topic for the first two terms of the school year will be World War 2. We will study many aspects of the war and try to give the children the best understanding of what life was like during the time of the war. We will study evacuees, major events of the war as well why it started, how it ended and who the key people were throughout the conflict. We will be using a number of props and resources to support this learning and should you have any that you wish to donate we would be more than grateful.

In our science sessions we will be looking at how light travels and carrying out a number of different experiments involving mirrors and prisms. We will look at how we see light and how the human eye is made-up as well as how rays of light can be reflected.

Our maths work will initially focus on number and place value and then look at cementing and developing the children's understanding of the four main number operations.

I am pleased to be working with the children again this year and as ever, should you have any queries, questions or concerns please feel free to come and see me.
