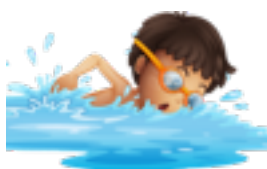


Forest School

As we begin the run up to Christmas we can look forward to a lot of fun things. We have the annual visit to the pantomime coming towards the end of the term and the Christingle and Christmas services to come at the church.



In order to begin preparing the children for secondary school we have also been placing a lot more emphasis on things such as homework and developing a sense of independence when learning.

Our Curriculum

Our connections topic for the first two terms of the school year will be World War 2. We will study many aspects of the war and try to give the children the best understanding of what life was like during the time of the war. We will study evacuees, major events of the war as well why it started, how it ended and who the key people were throughout the conflict. We will be using a number of props and resources to support this learning and should you have any that you wish to donate we would be more than grateful.

In our science sessions we will be looking at electricity. We will be thinking about how electricity moves through certain objects and what makes something either a conductor or an insulator.

Our maths work will focus on problem solving and then move towards using fractions in a number of different ways and ensuring that the children are good at calculating with fractions.
