Year 5 have been learning about living things and their habitats in Science. As part of this the children have looked at differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird and also the process of reproduction in some plants and animals. To complement our learning, Year 5 will be going on a trip to the Lincolnshire Wildlife Park on Monday 26th February 2018.

The day's experience will include a nature walk, Meerkat talk, primate talk, tiger talk, reptile handling and the opportunity to be up close and personal in the walk-through enclosure.

We will be leaving school at 9am and we will arrive back at school for the end of the day.
