

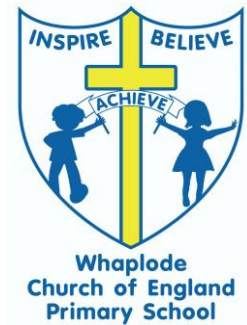

Park Safe, Walk Safe – Poster Competition

The yellow Zig Zags are there for a reason -

The School Parliament will decide which entries will be made into posters/banners
to support our safer parking campaign.

Here are some ideas for your design:

- Do not stop your car on the zig-zag lines
- It is illegal to park or 'stop and drop' on the zigzags
- Walking, scooting and cycling is good exercise – it keeps us healthy and is good for our hearts
- Try 'Park and Stride' – park at least 5 or 10 minutes away from the school and walk the rest of the way
- It is not safe or caring to park in the road directly outside the school
- It is better for our air quality to walk to school
- It is not safe to park in the street outside the school gates because it's difficult for pupils to cross the road

Use clear messages and bold clear colours and design (felt tips preferably) to make
it easier for people to read and understand our message.
