Dear Parents and Carers,

The government has requested that in order to continue to support the efforts around the Coronavirus outbreak, schools should be available to deal with any new positive cases during the start of the Christmas break.

Therefore, we are asking parents to inform us should your child test positive for Coronavirus, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of attending school. This would mean that if your child shows symptoms (and then tests positive) before Sunday 20th December, you MUST inform the school. The school will then work with PHE to identify the advice it should give to families. School staff are also being asked to inform us should they test positive during that 48-hour period. If your child becomes symptomatic (and then tests positive) from Sunday 20th December onwards, you do not need to inform the school.

Should you find yourself in this situation, we ask that you notify the school via email using the whaplode.reception@southlincs-hub.co.uk email address. Please do not call the school or leave a voicemail message as the office will not be manned from the end of term.

The emails will be checked twice every day up to and including Wednesday 23rd December, as requested by the DfE.

In the event of the school being notified of a positive case, we will contact parents with information and advice via email. Please check your emails regularly from the closure of school until 23rd December.

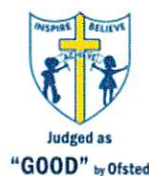
The school will only respond to emails relating to the reporting of a Covid positive case and any emails received after 23rd December will not be responded to until the start of the new term.
