Dear parents and carers,

Many thanks for your prompt response to our recent survey regarding your child attending school full time. The response was overwhelmingly positive and in light of the amazing way the children have settled into school this week, we can only assume they will do the same when we move to full time.

From Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September your child will be able to attend school on a full time basis. Their start time of 9:15am will remain the same and so will the collection time of 3.20pm.

Obviously, now that they are remaining at school for the full day, they will be enjoying lunch with us. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free lunch as part of the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal initiative. Meals are supplied by our lunch time provider Willoughby Foods and should be ordered through their website: <https://www.willoughby-foods.co.uk/parentLogin.asp>

With effect from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September, meals will need to be ordered online by parents/carers. The deadline for ordering these meals is midnight on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> September. You can order for the rest of the term or a week at a time. You will receive email reminders about ordering deadlines from Willoughby directly. If you require a reminder of log in details, please contact Willoughby Foods.

Some children may prefer to bring in a packed lunch from home. If that is the case, can we please remind you to ensure that you pack your child a healthy lunch and do not pack any items containing nuts (including chocolate spread containing nuts) as we have a number of pupils who have a severe allergic reaction when exposed to nuts. P.E day will remain the same for your children. Children should continue to bring in a filled water bottle and a small snack (plain biscuits or fruit).

We look forward to welcoming your child to school on a full-time basis. Should you have any further questions, do not hesitate to contact the school.
