Head of School Update

Welcome back after the half term break! Hopefully the children are all well rested and ready for our final term of the academic year.

We are delighted that so many of you visited the flower festival at St Mary's Church over the Bank Holiday weekend and commented on the children's displays. We were very proud of the creativity of our children (and staff!) and thought the church looked beautiful.

The swimming season is in full swing and progress is clear to see in all classes. The swimming pool committee volunteers give a huge amount of their own time to maintaining and cleaning the pool every day, in order to keep things in great condition ready for lessons. Our swimming pool is totally maintained by your donations and we would love to see you support us once again in raising much needed funds to keep the pool operational.
