Never swim alone. Always go with friends or family.

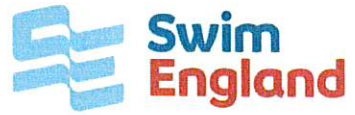
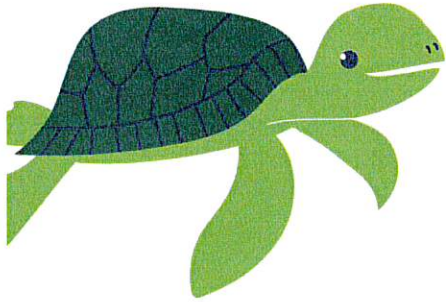
In an emergency:

FLOAT

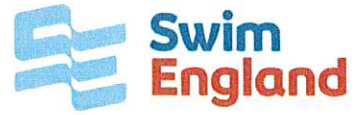
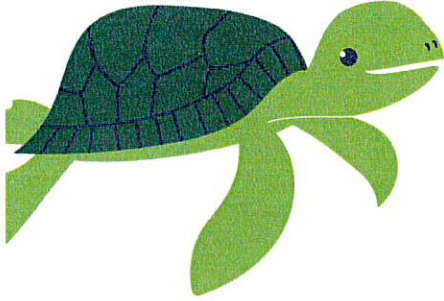
If you fall in, float or swim on your back. Throw something that floats to anyone who has fallen in.

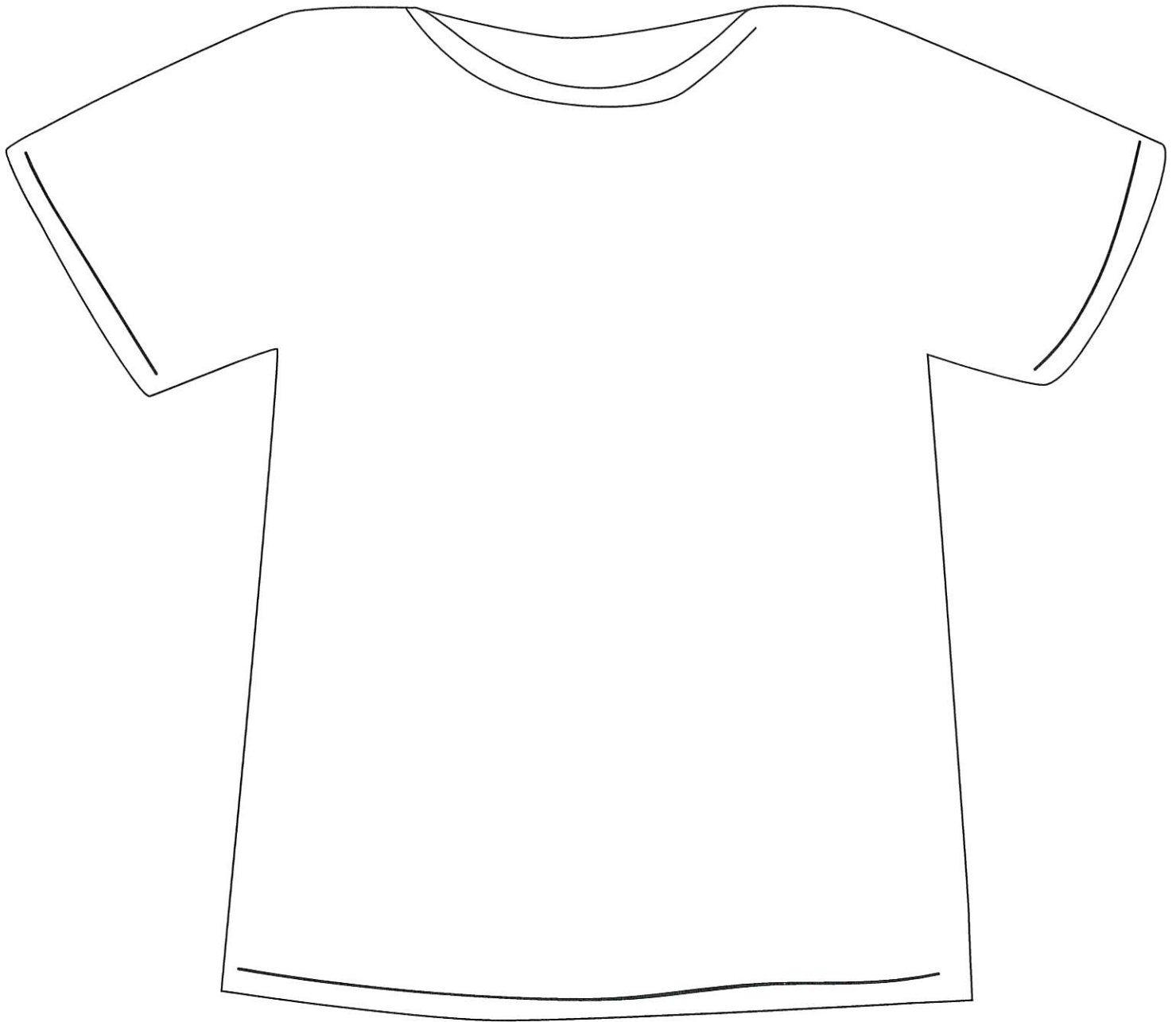
