### Maths

This half-term the children will be shape, position and direction, and decimals.

# Writing Skills

This half-term we will learn how to write a diary entry, imagining we are Scott of the Antarctic. We will also be writing a narrative based on The Fantastic Flying Books of Mr Morris Lessmore by Moonbot Studios.

# Reading Skills

This term we will begin reading *Runaway Robot* by Frank Cottrell-Boyce. We will be engaging with and reflecting on the text.

# History

This term we will learn about the Industrial Revolution. We will be learning about the significant inventions of the time and the impact the Industrial Revolution had on society today.

# Geography

This term we will begin learning about the physical and human geography of New Zealand.

## Science
