Timings:

Picnic Lunch:

Approximately 12 noon. Could we ask that after the Reception/ KS1 Sports Day has ended, parents find themselves a suitable spot to picnic. At noon, classes will be brought out to the field by teachers to find parents. Any pupils who do not have parents in attendance will eat lunch with their class, supervised by school staff. Please be aware that we are not able to allow pupils to eat lunch with other families unless we have been informed of this arrangement in writing.

At the end of lunch, we ask parents to clear the track area and return any school chairs to trackside in readiness for the KS2 events.

Leaving the site

Due to the number of staff being involved in Sports Day, we politely ask that you only request to leave the school site for emergency purposes. This will be via the main playground gate.

Toilets

Adults and pre-school children should access the toilets in the swimming pool.

Pre-school children

Please ensure that pre-school children remain with their parents at all times. They must not be allowed to run across the track at any point for the safety of all involved.

Spectator area

Spectators are asked to remain in the designated spectator area throughout the events.

End of Day:

At the end of the KS2 Sports Day, pupils should be collected from their classrooms. Please collect from KS2 fire exit doors. If you have children in younger classes, we will arrange collection for you. Should Sports Day finish before 3:20pm, children will be allowed to leave with their parents/ carers. If parents/ carers are not attending, pupils will remain in school until the end of the school day.
